

PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 7/2012-2013

Government Revenue based on Consumption Fees

WHEREAS the traditional sources of Government revenue based on consumption fees has served the Cayman Islands well;

AND WHEREAS these consumption fees are now reaching the point of diminishing returns where the cost of living for Caymanians is becoming onerous;

AND WHEREAS Caymanians pay transaction fees to Government;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT Government consider the introduction of a transaction fee on all Bank transactions and an annual deposit fee on all funds held on deposit at financial institutions in the Cayman islands. Such transaction fee to be no more that 0.0025 percent and the annual deposit fee to be no more that 0.05 percent, and that these funds be earmarked to reduce Government debt.
