INTRODUCTION

- 1. The Office of the Auditor General (OAG or Office) is committed to communicating on its operations regularly to the Public Accounts Committee (PAC). We currently report to PAC quarterly and subsequently make these reports available on our website.
- 2. The last report provided to the PAC was for 31 October 2015. Since the beginning of October, the Office was operating without an appointed Auditor General and it was decided because of other operational priorities during the interim period to brief PAC verbally when requested.
- 3. As the new Auditor General, I am committed to continuing the practice of providing the PAC with regular updates on the Office's operations to suit the PAC needs.

FINANCIAL AUDIT PRACTICE

EPS AUDITS

- 4. As shown in Exhibit 1, audit work on six of the seven Entire Public Sector (EPS) submissions has been completed and opinions issued.
- 5. We have completed our audit work on the 2014-15 EPS audit and should be in a position to issue our opinion by the end of August 2016. While 14 entity audits are still outstanding, we will be issuing our opinion that will obviously be affected by the process adopted by the Government.

ENTITY AUDITS

- 6. When we last reported at 31 October 2015, there were 9 entities outstanding from prior years although 4 were to all intents and purposes finished. Out of the 42 total 2014-15 audits we were required to complete by the 31 October 2015 deadline, we issued opinions for 23 by the statutory deadline, which is consistent with the prior year (23 opinions issued by 31 October 2014 deadline).
- 7. During the first half of 2016, we have continued to focus on the completion of all outstanding audits for all years but with a focus on the 2014-15 audits. As at 30 June 2016, there remain 14 audits to be completed for the 2014-15 year. We expect that the two remaining 2012-13 outstanding audits to be completed by the end of August and the five outstanding 2013-14 audits to be finalized in the next few months. We are concerned about the large number of outstanding audits for the 2014-15 year and have been working closely with government officials to move these ahead as quickly as possible with an objective of having our auditors focus on meeting our statutory deadlines for the 2015-16 audits. Our planning indicates that certain entities with backlogs are not expected to meet the 2015-16 statutory deadlines. We expect to have a better idea of how many will be late when we issue our September quarterly report.

8. Exhibit 2 provides a high level summary of the current state of audit completion and tabling of annual reports in the Legislative Assembly.

- 9. In 2015, we issued two general reports on performance and financial reporting of ministries, portfolios and offices and the statutory authorities and government companies for the 2012-13 and 2013-14 entity audits. The reports are available on our website.
- 10. We plan to issue one general report on performance and financial reporting of ministries, portfolios and offices and the statutory authorities and government companies relating to our work on the 2014-15 audits in December 2016.
- 11. A more detailed update on individual audits is contained in Appendices A through E.

PERFORMANCE AUDIT PRACTICE

- 12. During the first half of 2016, the OAG did not issue any performance audit reports.
- 13. There were three performance audits in progress as at 30 June as described in Exhibit 3.

- 14. Looking ahead, the Office does not currently have any performance audits or public interest reports planned to commence in the next three months.
- 15. Since arriving in post, I have been meeting with senior government officials and others in the community to get my own understanding of the issues and to assess the three year performance audit plan developed by the previous auditor general. Given our reporting relationship and its role, I believe the PAC members have a unique understanding of the issues. Therefore, I welcome regular feedback and input by the members of the PAC for ideas we could consider for future performance audits and public interest reports.

REPORTS REVIEWED BY PAC

- 16. The PAC recently reviewed eight reports issued by the Office over the last year and issued reports of its own requiring the Government to respond to its recommendations. The PAC is awaiting the official response from government officials to its recommendations.

OPERATIONAL REPORT

OAG OPERATIONAL UPDATE FOR 30 JUNE 2016

18. The audit of the financial statements and the annual report for 2014-15 was completed on 22 September 2015 and submitted to the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly on 2 October 2015, almost a month in advance of the statutory reporting date. The annual report was tabled in the Legislative Assembly on 27 April 2016.

OAG FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE FOR THE YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2016

- 19. Exhibit 5 provides details of the financial performance as at 30 June 2016. These figures are unaudited and are being finalized for audit for audit purposes. Based on the preliminary unaudited figures the OAG has generated a surplus of \$66,000 for the year ending 30 June 2016. A significant shortfall in revenue was offset by expenditures coming in under budget for the year. The drop in revenue is mainly attributed to being under-staffed in 2015-16 and therefore we were unable to bill out as much work as anticipated, which is consistent in the drop in expenditures that is mainly attributable to under-staffing of the available posts.
- 20. A more comprehensive review of the annual results will be provided in the annual report.
