#### 1. Reference

Following the Second Readings of the Supplementary Appropriation Bills for the years ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014, 2015 and 2016, the Bills stood committed to the Standing Finance Committee of the Legislative Assembly in accordance with the provisions of Standing Orders.
