PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 18/2017-2018

Motion to reduce availability of drugs in Her Majesty's Prison (HMP) Northward

WHEREAS there have been reports in the local press concerning drugs being found inside HMP Northward;

AND WHEREAS there is much public concern about drug use and availability of drugs within HMP Northward;

AND WHEREAS parents and spouses have expressed concern that during visitation they have observed behaviour indicating drug consumption;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Government considers introducing a system of random drug testing at HMP Northward for inmates and staff to determine the incidence of drug use within the prison and introduce additional methods of interdiction that can lead to a reduction or elimination of drugs within the prison;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the results of the program be published as a percentage of the prison population and staff.
