PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 14/2018-2019

Motion to set standards for the importation of vehicles

WHEREAS the Cayman Islands has experienced an unprecedented rate as which vehicles are being imported;

AND WHEREAS these imports continue to place significant pressure on the national roads infrastructure resulting in heavy traffic congestion and increased wear and tear, with the demand for more roads with multiple lanes, further increasing the costs to the national budget both in terms of infrastructure and human capital, while also placing increased pressure on the environment by way of excessive emissions;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT Government consider examining and make recommendations on the most suitable standards regarding the importation of vehicles such as by age limits, classification and/or fuel type;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Government considers implementing a policy by the end of the fiscal year 2019 as a matter of urgency.
