A BILL FOR A LAW TO APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS FOR THE 18-MONTH PERIOD ENDING 31 DECEMBER, 2017

THE APPROPRIATION (JULY 2016 TO DECEMBER 2017) BILL, 2016

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

It is necessary to enact in respect of each financial year an Appropriation Law giving the Cabinet authority to incur executive expenses, acquire executive assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing necessary for all services of the Government in that year in the manner directed by the Legislature.

This Bill seeks approval for those executive financial transactions for the 18-month period ending 31 December, 2017 under the categories set out in the Schedule to the Bill.
