- (a) deleting the word "and" at the end of paragraph (h);
- (b) deleting the full-stop at the end of paragraph (i) and substituting a semicolon;
- (c) inserting after paragraph (i) the word "and"; and
- (d) inserting after paragraph (i) the following paragraph-
 - "(j) facilitating the voluntary transfer of witnesses.".
