In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 48 and 119 of the Traffic Law (2003 Revision), the Governor in Cabinet makes the following regulations -

1. These regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) (Amendment) Regulations, 2007.

- 2. The Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2004 are amended in regulation 4 as follows -
 - (a) in paragraph (1)(c) by deleting the word "six" and substituting the word "four"; and
 - (b) by repealing paragraph (2).

Amendment of regulation 4 of the Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2004 - establishment of Public Transport Appeals Tribunal

- 3. The Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2004 are amended in regulation 6 by repealing paragraph (6) and substituting the following paragraph -
 - " (6) Four members of the Appeals Tribunal, including the chairman, present at any meeting shall form a quorum."
