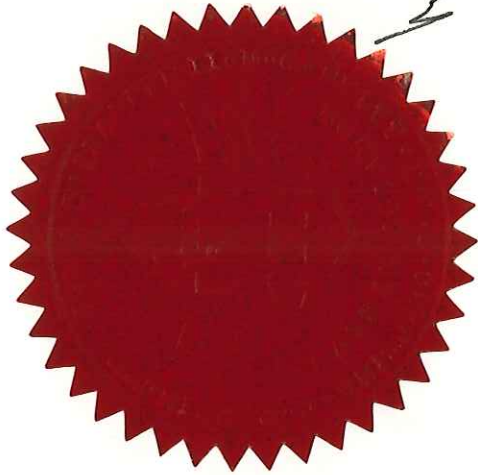




PROCLAMATION NO: 5 OF 1995

BY HIS EXCELLENCY MICHAEL
E J GORE, COMMANDER OF
THE ROYAL VICTORIAN ORDER AND
COMMANDER OF THE MOST EXCELLENT
ORDER OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE,
GOVERNOR OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

WHEREAS section 46(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the sessions of the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be held at such places and begin at such times as the Governor may from time to time by Proclamation appoint;

NOW THEREFORE, I, the Governor, by virtue of the power conferred on me by section 46(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands, **HEREBY PROCLAIM** that a session of the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be held at the Legislative Assembly Building in George Town on the island of Grand Cayman beginning at 10.00 am on Friday the 3rd day of March 1995.
