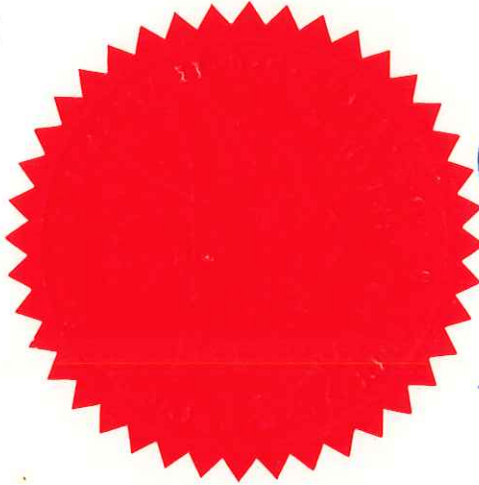

WHEREAS, by subsection (1) of section 46 of Schedule 2 of the Cayman Islands (Constitution) Order, 1972, it is provided that the Sessions of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at such time and place as the Governor may, from time to time, by Proclamation appoint;

NOW THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by the aforesaid Order, I, JOHN OWEN, Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor of the Cayman Islands, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AND MAKE KNOWN THAT A SESSION OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS shall be held in the Legislative Assembly Building in George Town, Island of Grand Cayman, at 10:00 a.m. on Friday the 7th day of March, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety Seven.
