THE BRITISH EMPIRE, GOVERNOR OF
THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

WHEREAS, by subsection (1) of section 47 of Schedule (2) of the Cayman Islands (Constitution) Order, 1972, it is provided that the Governor may, at any time, by Proclamation, prorogue or dissolve the Legislative Assembly.

NOW THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by the aforesaid order, I, John Owen, Companion of The Order of St. Michael and St. George, Member of The Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor of The Cayman Islands, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AND MAKE KNOWN THAT THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS shall be prorogued as from Tuesday the 16th day of February, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-nine.
