Whereas section 47(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the Governor may at any time, by Proclamation, prorogue or dissolve the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands;

And whereas section 47(2) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the Governor shall dissolve the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands at the expiration of four years from the date when the Legislative Assembly first meets after any general election unless it has been sooner dissolved;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STUART DUNCAN MACDONALD JACK, CVO, Commander of The Victorian Order, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 47(1) and (2) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands, HEREBY PROCLAIM that the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be dissolved as from Tuesday, the 24th day of March 2009.
