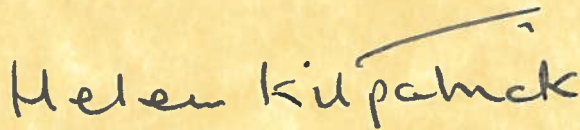

PROCLAMATION NO. 2 OF 2017

WHEREAS section 86(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that a general election of members of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at such time within two months after every dissolution of the Assembly as the Governor shall appoint by proclamation published in a Government Notice;

AND WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly was dissolved on the 28th day of March, 2017:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HELEN KILPATRICK, CB, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 86(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands, HEREBY PROCLAIM that a general election of members of the Legislative Assembly shall be held on Wednesday, the 24th day of May, 2017.
