PROCLAMATION NO. 1 OF 2017

BY HER EXCELLENCY HELEN KILPATRICK, COMPANION OF THE MOST HONOURABLE ORDER OF THE BATH, GOVERNOR OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

WHEREAS section 84(2) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the Governor, acting after consultation with the Premier, may at any time, by proclamation, dissolve the Legislative Assembly;

AND WHEREAS section 84(3) of the said Constitution provides that the Governor shall dissolve the Legislative Assembly at the expiration of four years from the date when the Assembly first meets after any general election unless it has been sooner dissolved pursuant to the Constitution:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HELEN KILPATRICK, CB, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 84(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands, HEREBY PROCLAIM that the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be dissolved as from Tuesday, the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017.
