PROCLAMATION NO. 1 OF 2021

BY HIS EXCELLENCY MARTYN ROPER, OFFICER OF THE MOST EXCELLENT ORDER OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE, GOVERNOR OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

WHEREAS section 84(2) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the Governor, acting after consultation with the Premier, may at any time, by proclamation, dissolve the Parliament;

AND WHEREAS section 84(3) of the said Constitution provides that the Governor shall dissolve the Parliament at the expiration of four years from the date when the Parliament first meets after any general election unless it has been sooner dissolved pursuant to the Constitution:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTYN ROPER, OBE, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 84(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands, HEREBY PROCLAIM that the Parliament of the Cayman Islands shall be dissolved as from Sunday the 14th day of February, 2021.

PROCLAMATION NO. 2 OF 2021

BY HIS EXCELLENCY MARTYN ROPER, OFFICER OF THE MOST EXCELLENT ORDER OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE, GOVERNOR OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

WHEREAS section 86(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that a general election of members of the Parliament shall be held at such time within two months after every dissolution of the Parliament as the Governor shall appoint by proclamation published in a Government Notice;

AND WHEREAS the Parliament was dissolved on the 14th day of February, 2021:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTYN ROPER, OBE, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 86(1) of the Constitution HEREBY PROCLAIM that a general election of members of the Parliament shall be held on Wednesday, the 14th day of April, 2021.
