#### **HOUSE QUORUM**

[Standing Order 13(2)]

The Premier, Hon. Alden McLaughlin: Madam Speaker, I repeat my earlier observation, that there is not a quorum present in the Chamber as required in accordance with Standing Order 13(1) as amended by section 74(1) of the Cayman Islands Constitution Order 2009.

**The Speaker:** Honourable Leader of the Opposition, do you have a point of order?

Hon. W. McKeeva Bush, Leader of the Opposition: Madam Speaker, I don't have a point of order, but I have an inquiry to make, if you allow it, and that is: What happened to these Members that they are absent at this time, particularly so that you didn't get a notification of their absence, and particularly so that this House, following a very serious process, a matter of procedure that the Speaker of this honourable House summoned? I don't know of any time that has ever been done in this legislature or had cause to be done. It could always be done because it's a process of parliamentary democracy and one that we adhere to. What happened to them since that, especially the one from West Bay that came in here and raised an objection and now gone?

I am concerned, in other words, Madam Speaker, in regard that these Members did not notify the Speaker, and after a process, as announced by the Speaker, they come now saying that they can't come here.

The Speaker: I have noted your expressions, and I would ask the Serjeant at this time, unfortunately or fortunately, we have to follow the same mundane procedure of giving five minutes to summon the Members who are not in the Chamber. And if after five minutes, we will have to move on to the next stage of this process. So, Serjeant, starting now, you have five minutes. We have received letters but there is nothing in the Standing Orders to say that if letters were received that I still can't summon. I have to . . . I am endeavouring to follow the Standing Orders to a T, so please summon the Members once again.

Hon. W. McKeeva Bush, Leader of the Opposition: It is an insult to the Speaker.

The Speaker: Members, please remain in your seats.

[Pause while Serjeant-at-Arms summon absent Members to attend the Legislative Assembly]

**The Speaker:** The Serjeant has indicated that those Members have not changed their minds. Hence, I find that the House is not quorate, and the House now stands adjourned.

Mr. V. Arden McLean, Elected Member for East End: Madam Speaker—
