OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend the Public Recorder Act (2010 Revision) to provide for a fifty per cent reduction in fees for older persons for the recording of a deed poll by the Public Recorder and for incidental and connected purposes.

Amendment of section 4 of the Public Recorder Act (2010 Revision) - documents for recording

- **2**. The *Public Recorder Act (2010 Revision)* is amended in section 4 by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection
 - "(2A) Notwithstanding subsection (2)(b), where a person who is sixtyfive years of age or older submits a deed poll to the Public Recorder to be recorded, the person shall pay to the Public Recorder fifty per cent of the fee specified in subsection (2)(b)."
