## ANSWER TO A PARLIAMENTARY QUESTION FROM NORTH SIDE MLA, D. EZZARD MILLER TO MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT, HON. WAYNE PANTON

#### QUESTION:

Can the Hon. Minister state:

- (a) Who authorised and who installed the dive buoys in the NO DIVE ZONE off the coast of Old Man Bay;
- (b) Who will remove them; and
- (c) When will they be removed?

### **ANSWER:**

Madam Speaker the answer -


To our knowledge, that is the Ministry of Environment and the Department of Environment ("DoE"), there are no dive moorings inside the boundaries of the Old Man Bay No Dive Zone.

DoE has installed 380 Public Moorings around the Islands in an effort to protect coral reefs from anchor damage, but none of the Public Moorings are located in any No Dive Zones.

The eastern boundary of the Old Man Bay No Dive Zone is gazetted as longitude 81 degrees 10 minutes and 0 seconds. The nearest Public Mooring is longitude 81 degrees 9 minutes and 57 seconds which is 222 feet east of the zone (please see attached map).

If a private individual has installed an unauthorized mooring it would be the responsibility of the Port Authority under section 29 of the Port Regulations 2011 to have the unauthorized mooring removed at the owners' expense.
