QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister say whether the Government has made it a priority to consider the critically important draft National Climate Change policy with a view to its formal adoption to protect the social, economic and environmental future of this Country?

ANSWER:

The Cabinet has approved Cayman Islands Climate Change Policy 2024-2050, which outlines a 26-year plan for our beloved Cayman Islands for adaptation and mitigation in order to achieve the Policy's vision of a climate-resilient Cayman Islands that promotes and sustains vibrant communities, a robust economy, and a thriving natural environment. The Climate Change Policy was also tabled in Parliament on 09 October 2024.
