### **QUESTION:**

Given that supplementary funding was specifically approved in the last Finance Committee meeting on 11 October 2024, can the Honourable Minister provide a timeline for completion of a new concrete Morgan's Harbour dock in West Bay South?

#### **ANSWER:**

Mr. Speaker, I am pleased to report that the project is progressing as planned. The business case has been approved, construction documents are finalized, and the application for the Coastal Works Licence is under review by the Ministry of Sustainability and Climate Resilience.

## The timeline for the project is as follows:

- The procurement process for the General Contractor commenced on November 29, 2024, via the Bonfire platform.
- Bid submissions will close on December 20, 2024, with the evaluation process and submission of the evaluation report to the PAHI-TD Entity Procurement Committee (EPC) expected by December 30, 2024.

The Government remains committed to delivering this essential infrastructure for the people of West Bay South, and we will continue to ensure the process is carried out efficiently and transparently.
