PARLIAMENTARY QUESTION ASKED BY

QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister provide an update on the Bimini Drive to Selkirk Drive Connector Road, including any potential timeline for gazettal and paving of the road?

ANSWER:

The Ministry is actively progressing the Bimini Drive to Selkirk Drive Connector Road project (Boundary Plan 660), which has evolved into a more comprehensive road scheme aimed at significantly improving traffic efficiency in the Grand Harbour area.

Boundary Plan 660 will be gazetted once the following two preconditions are satisfied:

- 1. Finalisation and agreement of a parking layout feasibility assessment with Grand Harbour merchants; and
- 2. Selection of a qualified engineering design firm through an open tender process.

Road paving and related works will proceed following gazettal, land acquisition, and completion of detailed engineering designs. The Ministry remains fully committed to delivering this strategic infrastructure project and will continue to provide updates as further progress is made, particularly as key milestones are achieved.
