QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister advise whether there is a scheduled and regularly reviewed maintenance programme for drains in flood-prone areas within George Town?

ANSWER:

Yes. The National Roads Authority (NRA) has a scheduled and regularly reviewed maintenance programme for stormwater drainage wells across Grand Cayman — including those located in flood-prone areas of George Town.

At present, the NRA maintains approximately 4,700 public road drains. In areas known to be more susceptible to flooding, maintenance activity is increased, in the weeks leading up to the rainy season.
