QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister say whether the Government intends to implement a new minimum wage, and if so, when and how much?

ANSWER:

Yes, unlike previous administrations who couldn't find the consensus to make a decision on this important matter. We, the National Coalition For Caymanians, intend to accept and implement the recommendation of the Minimum Wage Advisory Committee Final Report that was submitted in 2023 under the previous Government. We intend to implement the national minimum wage of CI\$8.75 per hour effective January 1, 2026.
