QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister please advise who drives the decision process for bus shelter requests; and say how many have been built this year?

ANSWER:

There are currently more than eighty bus shelters across Grand Cayman. These shelters are supplied, installed, maintained, and owned by Rotary Central Cayman. Rotary funds their construction and upkeep and, in turn, benefits from the advertising revenue generated from them.
