QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister please advise if the Bodden Town James Manoah Bodden Civic Centre will be refurbished, or has it been destroyed beyond repair?

ANSWER:

Mr. Speaker, following the latest incident at the James Manoah Bodden Civic Centre, a structural survey was carried out, and I can confirm that the building is not destroyed beyond repair.

The Department of Facilities Management has advised that the first phase of remediation — which involves clearing damaged debris and securing the site — will take place in the coming weeks. The remaining works will proceed after the required procurement process, which is expected to begin in early 2026.

This Honourable House can be assured, Mr. Speaker, that every effort is being made to restore this important community facility for the people of Bodden Town.
