Honouring the Life and Service of Former MP, Austin Harris

We reflect with deep respect on the life and service of the late **Mr. Austin Osmond Harris**, former Parliamentarian and Member of Parliament for the electoral district of Prospect. Mr. Harris devoted much of his life to the people of the Cayman Islands — both as a public representative and as a voice in the national conversation.

As an elected representative, he was deeply involved in community development efforts. Mr. Harris championed local initiatives such as community beautification and safety projects, regularly engaging with constituents to address pressing concerns including infrastructure, and neighbourhood wellbeing.

Beyond his parliamentary service, Mr. Harris was widely known throughout the Cayman Islands as a long-time talk-show host and commentator.
