**MOTION TO RECOMMEND CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS FOR ELECTORAL
REPRESENTATION OF TRADITIONAL DISTRICTS ON GRAND CAYMAN**

WHEREAS the Cayman Islands Constitution establishes the framework for the democratic representation of the people;

AND WHEREAS the principle of fair and equitable representation of all electoral districts is fundamental to the effective functioning of parliamentary democracy;

AND WHEREAS the electoral districts of North Side and East End have historically maintained distinct cultural and communal identities deserving of independent representation in Parliament;

AND WHEREAS the Electoral Boundary Commission raised concerns about the population size of North Side and East End being lesser than other constituencies;

AND WHEREAS the electoral district of Cayman Brac and Little Cayman is constitutionally guaranteed two Members of Parliament to ensure fair representation of smaller communities;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that this Honourable House recommends amending the Cayman Islands Constitution Order 2009 (as amended) to include a provision guaranteeing that there is at least one Parliamentary representative from each of the five traditional districts, namely:

- West Bay;
- George Town;
- Bodden Town;
- East End; and
- North Side
