QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister say, when will the land in the new Pease Bay cemetery in Bodden Town be filled in to the north of the property?

ANSWER:

The Department of Environmental Health typically undertakes land filling on an as-needed basis, coinciding with the construction of burial vaults to ensure that works are carried out in a practical and cost-effective manner. Accordingly, the area is developed incrementally rather than in a single phase, based on operational requirements and the availability of funding.

Notwithstanding this approach, we are planning to fill and level the land at the Pease Bay by the end of summer 2026.
