**QUESTION:**

Can the Honourable Minister say:

- a. how many vacation days were Cayman Islands Monetary Authority (CIMA) employees entitled to for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025; and
- b. how many vacation days were used by Cayman Islands Monetary Authority (CIMA) employees for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025?

**ANSWER:**

Based on readily available information for the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority, the total accumulated vacation days entitlement for all staff by year is as follows:

- 2023 – 6,836 days accumulated for all staff
- 2024 - 6,346 days accumulated for all staff
- 2025 – 8,432 days accumulated for all staff

The total vacation days taken for all staff by year is as follows:

- 2023 – 5,833 days taken by all staff
- 2024 – 5,309 days taken by all staff
- 2025 – 7,123 days taken by all staff
