**QUESTION:**

Can the Honourable Minister say how many sick days were incurred by staff at the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority (CIMA) for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025?

**ANSWER:**

Based on readily available information for the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority, the total number of sick days incurred for all staff by year is as follows:

- 2023 – 386 days
- 2024 – 464.5 days
- 2025 – 753 days
