**QUESTION:**

Can the Honourable Minister say how much did the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority (CIMA) spend on Duty Allowances for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025?

**ANSWER:**

Based on readily available information for the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority, the total spending on duty allowances by year was as follows:

- 2023: \$214,403.40
- 2024: \$21,383.27
- 2025: \$157,570.57
