QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister say, when will the affordable lands in East End be available for sale and will the Government consider another initiative as such?

ANSWER:

The initiative involving the Cayman Islands Government purchasing a large tract of residential development land in East End, filling, servicing and subdividing the land, and offering the individual parcels for sale to qualifying Caymanians, is progressing well.

Ministry staff are currently preparing a policy document, which is expected to be completed by Easter 2026. Once finalised, the policy will be submitted to Cabinet for review and approval.

The Government is also actively exploring additional land and locations where similar initiatives may be implemented across the Islands.
