**QUESTION:**

Can the Honourable Minister advise what roadworks projects are planned for implementation within the Red Bay and Prospect constituencies during the current Parliamentary Term, and the anticipated commencement and completion dates for each project?

**ANSWER:**

The National Roads Authority has identified a number of projects within the Red Bay and Prospect constituencies.

These include:

1. Deceleration/acceleration lane at Selkirk drive.
2. Speed humps on Selkirk drive
3. Grade and install temp spray/chip surface on the connector road between Bimini and Selkirk drive.
4. Speed hump by Eddie Sanchez park.
