QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister advise the start date of the east-west arterial road and where does the first phase end?

ANSWER:

The East–West Arterial Road remains a priority infrastructure project aimed at improving connectivity, traffic flow and long-term resilience between the central and eastern districts.

I am reliably informed by the NRA, that the survey work, will begin April of this year. The Prenotifications to landowners have been completed.

The final gazette will be presented to cabinet shortly, with anticipated work to begin in September.
