PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 2/2020-2021

Compliance with Section 119 of the Cayman Islands Constitution Order 2009

WHEREAS the Cayman Islands Constitution Order 2009 (the Constitution), Section 119 states:

“Subject to this Constitution, a law enacted by the Legislature shall provide for the establishment, functions and jurisdiction of Councils for each electoral district to operate as advisory bodies to the elected members of the Legislative Assembly”

AND WHEREAS the Advisory District Councils Law, 2011 was assented to by His Excellency Duncan Taylor on the 1st of February 2011;

AND WHEREAS Section 4 of The Advisory District Councils Law, 2011 requires that the Governor in Cabinet appoint the members of each Advisory District Council and that the Governor in Cabinet shall be cognizant of recommendations made to him from within the electoral districts;

AND WHEREAS Section 8 of The Advisory District Councils Law, 2011 states that The Governor in Cabinet may make regulations for the proper and efficient carrying out of the functions of the Councils;

AND WHEREAS to date the appointment of members to the Advisory District Councils and the creation of regulations required to properly implement the law has not been completed;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Legislative Assembly hereby establishes a Select Committee of the whole House to review the Advisory District Councils Law, 2011 and make a report to the House with recommended changes.
