QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Deputy Governor say if the Royal Cayman Islands Police Service currently has a tow truck?

ANSWER:

Thank you, Mr Speaker.

I thank the Honourable Member for the question.

The RCIPS does not own a tow truck. Towing services are provided by at least 3 different private companies depending which one is available at the time of the request, and can only be authorised by the on-duty Inspector. There is no plan in place for the RCIPS to purchase a tow truck.
