**QUESTION:**

Can the Honourable Minister say:

- a. how many sick days were incurred by staff at the Port Authority for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025; and
- b. how many sick days were incurred by staff at the Airport Authority for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025?

**ANSWER:**

**A. How many sick days were incurred by staff at the Port Authority for the years 2016 through to 2025?**

The Port Authority of the Cayman Islands has advised that it was unable to provide the requested information within the required timeframe. The information will be submitted once available.

**B. How many sick days were incurred by staff at the Airports Authority for the years 2016 through to 2025?**

The Cayman Islands Airports Authority has advised that sick leave records for 2016 through 2021 were maintained manually and are currently archived. Retrieval would require a manual review of archived files and additional administrative support.

For the period where electronic records are available, the Authority provides the following data:

<b>Year</b>	<b>Staff Complement</b>	<b>Sick Days Taken</b>
2022	152	610.5
2023	186	847
2024	209	877.5
2025	229	916.

These figures represent the total sick leave recorded across the Authority for each calendar year.
