**QUESTION:**

Can the Honourable Minister say:

- a. how much did the Port Authority spend on overtime for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025; and
- b. how much did the Airport Authority spend on overtime for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025?

**ANSWER:**

**A. How much did the Port Authority spend on overtime for the years 2016–2025?**

The Port Authority compensates staff for hours worked beyond their standard schedule. Due to the operational nature of the Port, these payments are categorised differently within the Authority's payroll system.

Some historical records require manual retrieval due to legacy payroll systems and archived data. Years 2016-2022 (marked with asterisk) are currently being retrieved and will be provided once available.

The readily accessible information is as follows:

**B. How much did the Airport Authority spend on overtime for the years 2016–2025?**

The Cayman Islands Airports Authority has advised that overtime expenditure for the period **2016 through 2025** is as follows:
