QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister say:

- a. how many employees at the Port Authority were over the age of 65 broken down by nationality (Caymanian vs non-Caymanian) as at December 31 for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025; and
- b. how many employees at the Airport Authority were over the age of 65 broken down by nationality (Caymanian vs non-Caymanian) as at December 31 for the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025?

ANSWER:

A. How many employees at the Airports Authority over age 65 broken down by nationality?

The Cayman Islands Airports Authority confirms the following number of employees over the age of 65, **broken down by nationality:**

These figures represent the total number of employees aged over 65 in each respective year.

B. How many employees at the Port Authority over age 65 broken down by nationality?

The Port Authority has provided the following breakdown of employees over the age of 65, **broken down by nationality**:

2022	2	0

2025	4	0

At present, there are no non-Caymanian employees over the age of 65, and those Caymanian employees working beyond the normal retirement age are engaged on short-term contracts following their retirement date.
