PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 17 of 2025-2026

CONSOLIDATION AND PROTECTION OF THE CENTRAL SCRANTON PARK

WHEREAS the vision for Central Scranton Park (CSP) was formally initiated by the Member of Parliament for George Town Central during his tenure as Minister;

AND WHEREAS the Cabinet paper authored and submitted by the Representative for George Town Central established the government's commitment to this project as a vital piece of social infrastructure;

AND WHEREAS the development involves the following parcels in their entirety:

- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 19**
- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 23**
- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 126**
- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 184**
- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 190**
- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 192**
- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 193**
- **Block 14CJ, Parcel 200**

AND WHEREAS a specific portion of **Block 14CJ, Parcel 182**—specifically the northern section currently utilised for the Park's development and situated north of the Government Administration Building parking lot is also required for the Park's completion;

AND WHEREAS the **Parks Foundation** has identified and affirmed the critical need for this development to serve three primary pillars of community well-being:

1. **A Dedicated Senior Centre:** To provide the first-of-its-kind facility for the elderly within the constituency.
2. **A Youth Center:** To offer a safe, constructive environment for the development and empowerment of young people.
3. **Community Green Space:** To preserve vital green space within the capital, providing essential mental health benefits and environmental freedom for residents.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Government considers the immediate excision of the northern portion of **Block 14CJ, Parcel 182** as identified by the Park's development boundaries;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Government considers the consolidation of this excised portion with the other eight identified parcels into a single land title;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Government considers classifying the resulting consolidated land as a **Park and Community Resource for Public Purposes**, ensuring its preservation in perpetuity for the purposes of senior care, youth development, and environmental conservation.
