QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister say if his Ministry has made any financial contributions for the removal of the Old-Style Caymanian home on the corner of Goring Avenue and relocation to the Bobby Thompson's way? And if so, to whom was the funds given and what amount was requested?

ANSWER:

The Ministry of Youth, Sports, Culture & Heritage did not make any contributions of a financial nature to the removal and relocation of the Old-Style Caymanian home, known as the Llewellyn House, from the corner of Goring Avenue to its new location on Bobby Thompson Way. However, the Ministry provided valuable support, and led the coordination to ensure the preservation and relocation of this historical structure.
