No. 8: Can the Honourable Minister provide a status update on the proposed road project intended to connect the junction of Eastern Avenue and Godfrey Nixon Way through to the waterfront at Seafarers Way, and specifically outline the current stage of planning or construction and the expected timeline for its completion?
