QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister provide a status update on the proposed road project intended to connect the junction of Eastern Avenue and Godfrey Nixon Way through to the waterfront at Seafarers Way, and specifically outline the current stage of planning or construction and the expected timeline for its completion?

ANSWER:

Mr Speaker, the Godfrey Nixon/Seafarers Collector Road project has advanced significantly over the past year, with many of the original property and compensation matters now resolved and substantial portions of the roadway completed. For example, the section between North Church Street and Diaz Lane is substantially complete. Final negotiations are underway and the Ministry remains committed to working with all parties to bring the project to a successful conclusion and deliver this important connection between Eastern Avenue, Godfrey Nixon Way and the waterfront at Seafarers Way.
