OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill amends Schedule 4 of the Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Act (2018 Revision) to include a notary public to the list of persons who must disclose expunged criminal records and for connected purposes.

Clause 1 provides the short title and commencement of the legislation.

Clause 2 defines the word “Act” to mean the Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Act (2018 Revision).

Clause 3 amends Part 1 of Schedule 4 to insert notaries public to the list of persons who must disclose expunged criminal records under the Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Act (2018 Revision).

Short title and commencement

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) (Amendment) Act, 2026.
(2) This Act comes into force immediately after the *Notaries Public (Amendment) Act, 2026* comes into force.

Interpretation

2. In this Act —

“**Act**” means the *Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Act (2018 Revision)*.

3. The *Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Act (2018 Revision)* is amended in Part 1 of Schedule 4, by inserting after paragraph 5 the following paragraph —
